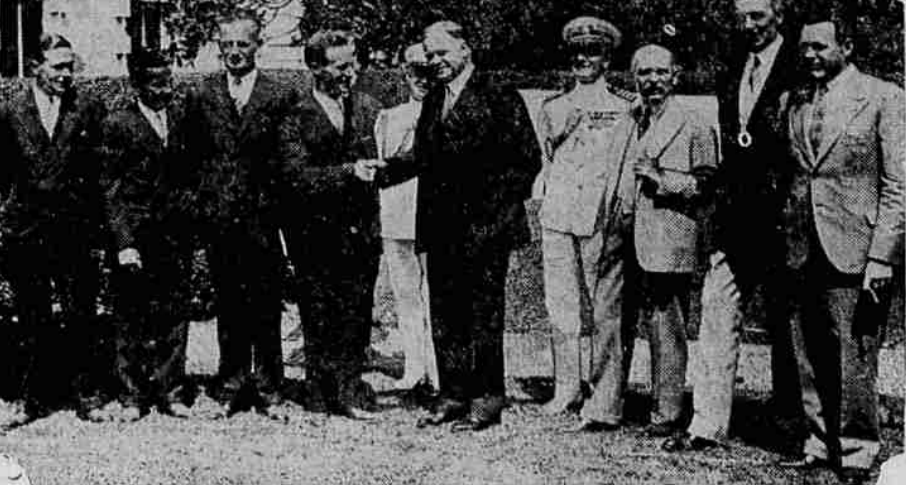


LOCAL BRIEFS
