Farm Help And Tariff Kansas Primary Issues

TOPEKA, Kas. (AP)—The tariff and
farm relief will play spotlight roles in
the Kansas primary August 5.
Three former governors seek nom-
ination for the two senatorships, now
filled by the two republican members
of the trio, in an election that will
determine party candidates for 10
congressional seats.

Unopposed in his own party for a
third term, Senator Arthur Capper
will have as his democratic opponent
in the November election, Jonathan
M. Davis, picturesque former demo-
cratic governor who as a "dirt farm-
er" candidate seven years ago rode
into the office for a brief but stormy
term.

Davis, unopposed, said that Sen-
ator Capper had "deserted the Kan-
sas farmer" on the tariff question "in
falling to support of debenture plan."

Senator Capper, owner of a daily
newspaper and numerous farm pub-
lications, has been regarded by his po-
litical friends as a champion of the
farmers' interests.

Senator Henry J. Allen has three
opponents for the republication nom-
ination for the senate.

He is opposed by Representative W.
H. Sproul, of the third district; Ralph
Snyder, former president of the Kan-
sas farm bureau; and James P. Getty,
Kansas City attorney.

Seeking a second term, Gov. Reed
has as a republican opponent Frank
"Chief" Hauke, former state com-
mander of the American legion.
Another former commander of the leg-
ion, Harry Woodring, and Noah L.
Bowman, are in quest of the demo-
cratic nomination.

Three women are candidates for
representatives to congress.

Teachers Paid \$4 A Month In Haiti

NEW YORK, July 15 (AP)—Rural
Haiti depends for its education on
teachers who are paid four or five
dollars a month. Dr. Robert B. Mo-
ton, principal of Tuskegee institute
and head of President Hoover's Haiti-
an commission on education, said
Monday on his return with the com-
mission from a 24-day tour of the
island.

Dr. Moton said the commission's
report will be completed and sent to
the president within a few days.
