Fruit Ice Box Cake
1 tablespoon granulated gelatin

4 tablespoons cold water
3 tablespoons butter
4 tablespoons flour
2 cups milk
3 egg yolks
1 teaspoon vanilla
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon lemon extract
3 egg whites
1 cup peaches
1 cup diced pineapple
2-3 cup vinegar

Soak gelatin and cold water for 5 minutes. Dissolve over pan of hot water. Cool. Melt butter and add flour and add milk and cook until creamy sauce forms. Add egg yolks and beat 2 minutes. Add rest of ingredients and pour into glass, mold which has been lined with lady fingers. Chill 24 hours. Turn out on platter and surround with whipped cream.

Tempting Tea Cakes
1/2 cup butter
1 cup sugar
2 eggs
1 teaspoon lemon extract
1/2 teaspoon vanilla
1/2 teaspoon salt
2-3 cup milk
2 cups flour
3 teaspoons baking powder
1/2 cup candied orange peel

Cream butter until soft. Add sugar and mix until very creamy. Add rest of ingredients and beat 3 minutes. Half fill greased muffin pan. Bake 15 minutes in moderate oven. Cool and frost.

Dainty Frosting
2 egg whites, stiffly beaten
2 tablespoons orange juice
1/2 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon lemon extract
1-3 cups sifted confectioner's sugar

Beat egg whites until very stiff. Add rest of ingredients. Mix well. Carefully frost the tops and sides of cake.
