Soviet Refuses To Assume Debts Of The Czarists

MOSCOW, Aug. 6 (AP)—Investia, organ of the Soviet government, in an editorial Tuesday serves notice on "capitalistic countries" the Soviet cannot assume the obligations of the czarists which it repudiated "since creation of the bolshevik regime in 1917." The editorial, obviously inspired by the Kremlin, says: "It is time for capitalistic countries to understand, once and for all, that the Soviet government cannot assume the obligations of the czarist government." "Ever since 1905 our revolutionary parties have warned international capital to extend no loans to the czarist government. We have not departed in any way from this position."
