Red Army Prepared To Defend Russia

MOSCOW, Feb. 24 (AP) — The Red army yesterday celebrated its thirtieth anniversary with parades, speeches and other enthusiastic evidences that it was ready to defend Russia against any invasion.

The commissar of war, Vofoshilov, issued an order of the day bidding the army be on its mettle because, he said, the country was being continually threatened by "capitalistic war."

Russia stands for peace, he said, but this did not mean that the country would permit any invasion of its rights.

According to government figures the Red army numbers 522,000, which officials declare is the smallest in proportion to total population in all of Europe.

May Settle Dispute On Irrigation Power

KIAMATH FALLS, Feb. 24 (AP) — Two significant developments have been taken here toward settlement of disputes between the California-Oregon Power company and the Kiamath irrigation district.

The power company has offered a contract granting owners of pumps of less than 100 horsepower new low rates, and offers to abolish the rule requiring a large deposit or advance payment on newly installed pumps.

The board of the Kiamath irrigation district had endorsed a bill before the legislature which would permit the power company to construct its proposed \$1,000,000 hydro-electric development at the grant site on the Kiamath river.

Bill to Speed Work On Public Buildings

WASHINGTON, Feb. 24 (AP) — A house bill to speed the construction of the public building program through elimination of delay involved in condemnation proceedings was passed yesterday by the senate. It now goes to the White House.

The measure, applying to public construction outside the District of Columbia, would enable the government to begin work without awaiting final judgment in the condemnation proceedings.

A similar measure for the District of Columbia was passed in 1929. Proponents argued that it would protect the rights of property owners since the amount of compensation would be determined by the ordinary court procedure.

Dem Committee Will Consider Future Policies

WASHINGTON, Feb. 24 (AP) — What the Democratic national committee may or may not have in regard to lining up the Democratic national committee on the wet side of the prohibition fence, dry members of the group are set for an aggressive try at squelching any such plan.

The committee will meet here March 5, at the chairman's call. Future policies he announced will form a topic for discussion. Rumors have been current that a resolution is being framed to push this steering group of the party off the prohibition fence. The rumors have not been denied.

Some of the dry Democrats on Capitol hill have been roused to a fever heat of activity. Yesterday Senator Morrison of North Carolina, party member of the senate but no newcomer to national politics, asserted his group had sufficient votes to defeat any wet resolution. He is North Carolina's national committeeman. Other Democratic leaders in congress are trying to head off the issue by having the rumored resolution shelved now.

Senator George of Georgia, who joined the group, asserting the committee has no right to form party policies, a function he holds belongs to the national convention. This view has been communicated to the chairman. Incidentally the active drys count upon the support of Senator Robinson of Arkansas, in a pinch. He was the running mate of Alfred E. Smith in the 1928 ticket and is party leader in the senate.

While prohibition engendered most of the agitated Democrats, one Representative Hull of Tennessee, came forward with an expression of concern that an undercover effort was impending to give the party committee a high tariff program. Recently he called upon the party to assert a vigorous stand opposed to Republican tariff policies.

The impending meeting, already drawing interest away from the closing days of congress, has brought out a crop of presidential candidates. Most of those being boomed are far from dry.

Governor Roosevelt of New York, remains the most discussed possibility here. But the name of Governor Ritchie, of Maryland, and Senator-elect James Hamilton Lewis of Illinois, are among those being advanced by friends.

75 Farmers Wait On Governor Meier

SALEM, Ore., Feb. 24 (AP) — Seventy-five farmers from Washington, Polk, Yamhill and Marion counties waited on Governor Meier yesterday, requesting the governor to use his influence to bring pressure to bear on the legislature to obtain passage of measures relieving the rent property tax.

The delegation was headed by James Burdett of McMinnville. Governor Meier pledged his support to any extent within the jurisdiction of his office.

Committee Split on State Police Bill

SALEM, Feb. 24 (AP) — The senate committee on revision of laws Monday afternoon voted to report Governor Meier's state police bill out to the senate with a majority recommendation that it do not pass. Signaling the majority report were Senators Strayer, Hall and Francis. Senator Eady announced he would submit a minority report favoring passage of the bill.

Senator Bailey, chairman of the committee, said that he had decided whether he would join forces with the majority or the minority report.

The divided report means that the fate of the bill in the senate will be decided on the question of indefinite postponement.

Drop Charges In "Sketch Book" Case

CHICAGO, Feb. 24 (AP) — Charges against 25 chorus girls and four principals of Earl Carroll's "Sketch Book" participating in an obscene and indecent performance were dismissed Saturday by Judge Justin F. McCarthy who sustained defense motions to end the trial.
