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Butter Slumps One Cent Today In Oregon Mart

PORTLAND, Mar. 19 (AP) — Quotations on wholesale butter were 1 cent lower on all grades except extras for today's opening of the market. Quota: extras 28¢ a pound, standards 28¢, prime firsts 27¢ and firsts 25¢. Demand was sufficient for moderately light supplies. Best call was for 80-90 score with little inquiry for limited supplies of top grade cubes.

The butter decline was followed in the butterfat market by a 1¢ cut in the bid price to 27¢ delivered Portland. Wholesale milk handlers announced a 10¢ drop in buying prices account of over supply. Quota: grade B, \$1.90 and C grade \$1.40 a cwt.

Opening egg market tone was fully steady with supplies less liberal and premiums were offered for eggs of good storage quality. That a rise in prices is due was hinted in some quarters. Increasing supplies in the fresh fruit and vegetable trade effected downward prices in some lines. Asparagus topped at 15¢ a pound, 5¢ below recent quotations. Tomatoes were down 25¢ to around \$3.50 to \$4.50 a box, and local spinach at 90¢ to \$1.00 a box was off about 10¢.

Hothouse rhubarb of good quality was less plentiful and quoted up 10¢ at \$1.00 to \$1.25 a box. Government market news service reported:

The old adage relative to "the proof of the pudding" in today's vegetable parlance reads—the proof of the excellence of Roseburg's cauliflower crop lies in the active eastern demand for this product. California's shipments are now heavy in the vegetable market of 63 cars daily, but quality is mostly that of ordinary Roseburg flower is of very high quality, and eastern demand exceeds the supply. As a result, shipments in northwestern markets are light, with a preponderance of No. 2 stock. Most of the eastern carload movement consists of No. 1 stock. The market is firm at \$1.00 per crate of No. 1, cash to growers.

Local cauliflower supplies are increasing daily, and the market is firm at \$1.25 to \$1.50 per crate, to retailers. Cauliflower are firm at Portland, with a 15-20¢ increase. Retailers are now paying around 75¢ per cwt. for good Oregon yellows.
