Two National league teams, Pittsburgh and Chicago, clashed at Los Angeles with Pittsburgh the winner by a score of 11 to 7. Captain Ike Francouer cleaned out five hits in five trips to the plate. In the fourth inning he bagged a double and a homer, one of five which featured the game.
