Thousands View Casket in Both Chicago and South Bend, Indiana.

SOUTH BEND, Ind., April 2 (AP)—Knute Rockne was back "home" today. His spical odyssey on earth was near trail's end.

blanketed casket in a quiet, modest funeral home on North Michigan street just three short miles from the campus of old Notre Dame. The great Nordic chieftain of American football and good sportsmanship, who but four days ago left South Bend and Notre Dame with a broad smile on his face, was back "home" with the boys he loved so well and with those who loved him and who will cherish his memory forever. But instead of ecstasy and joy, he brought sadness and despair. He was dead and so were the hearts of the thousands who found it so hard to believe that their "Rock" could pass on so tragically at the very zenith of his glory—of Notre Dame's glory.
