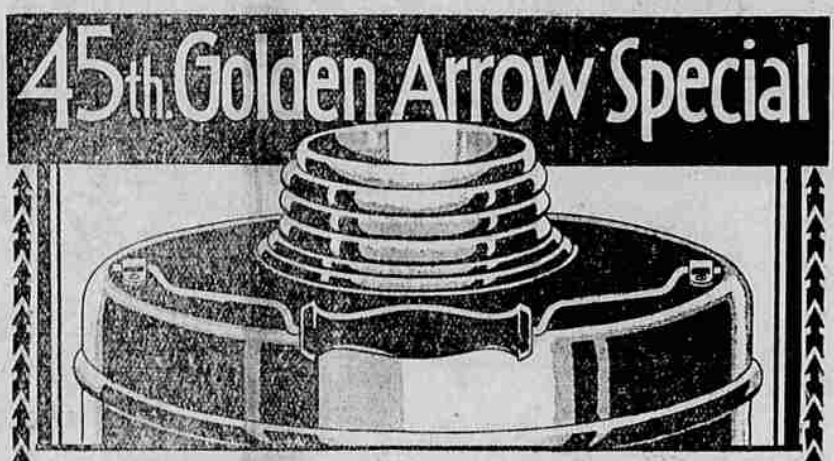

Menus of The Day

APRIL LUNCHEON MENU
Tuna Cocktail
Chicken and Mushroom Loaf
Creamed New Potatoes
Buttered Asparagus
Bread
Cherry Conserve
Fruit Gelatin Salads
Mayonnaise
Strawberry Ice Box Cake
Coffee

Tuna Cocktail, Serving 8
1 cup tuna, flaked apart
1 cup diced celery
4 tablespoons chopped sweet pickles
4 tablespoons chopped pimientos
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/2 cup mayonnaise
Mix half the mayonnaise with rest of ingredients. Chill. Serve in small glass cups which have been lined with lettuce. Top with the remaining mayonnaise.
Chicken and Mushroom Loaf
2 cups diced, cooked chicken
4 tablespoons chopped, cooked green pepper
3 tablespoons chopped, cooked celery
2 tablespoons pimientos
1 tablespoon chopped parsley
1 cup cooked mushrooms, diced
2 eggs
2-3 cup soft bread crumbs.
1 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon paprika
3 tablespoons chicken fat or butter, melted.
Mix the ingredients. Pour into a buttered loaf pan. Bake for 30 minutes in a moderate oven. Unmold carefully and serve warm, cut in slices. Make a thick white sauce and serve on the loaf slices.
Strawberry Ice Box Cake
1 round sponge cake
1/2 cup sugar
3 tablespoons flour
1/2 teaspoon salt
2 egg yolks
1-3 cups milk
2 egg whites, beaten
1 cup whipped cream
1 teaspoon vanilla
1 tablespoon granulated gelatin
3 tablespoons cold water
3 cups berries, washed and hulled
1/2 cup confectioner's sugar
The sponge cake should be 24 hours old. Remove the center crumbs so a round case remains. Mix the sugar and flour, add the egg yolks and milk. Cook in a double boiler until thick and creamy. Stir frequently. Add the gelatin which has soaked 5 minutes with the water. Mix well and add the egg whites, vanilla and whipped cream. Pour into the sponge cake case. Chill for several hours. Arrange on a serving platter and top and surround with the berries which have been chilled and mixed with the confectioner's sugar.

Teachers Trained At E. O. N. Do Well

ONTARIO, Apr. 24 (AP)—Four former Eastern Oregon Normal school students, now teachers in Malheur county, were winners of the eight first places in spelling contests held at the Oregon Trail school, April 22. Eight schools were represented in these contests and the competition was high. These teachers brought to these contests well conceived pupils. Owen Price, of Myra schools, was winner of four first places; Marion Caldwell, of the Wade school, winner of two first places; Mrs. Victoria Schweizer, of Kingsley school, was winner of one first place; and Albert Hopkins, of Oregon Trail school, was winner of one first place.

Mr. Hopkins had charge of these contests. Spelling contests in Malheur county in the past have created interest, which was at its peak this year.
