BUTTER PRICE DROPS TODAY OVER OREGON

PORTLAND, May 14 (AP)—Quotations on wholesale butter opened lower on all four grades today as result of the slackening of demand which this week followed completion of active buying to complete a number of large shipping orders. Extras and standards were quoted 1 cent lower at 24 and 23 cents respectively per pound while prime firsts and firsts were listed 2 cents lower at 22 and 21 cents respectively. Receipts were liberal, causing price concessions to move stock in some quarters. Creameries reduced bids for butterfat 2 cents to 20 cents delivered to be in line with the butter decline. Wholesale egg market continued weak and unsettled with receipts greater than demand but ruling quotations were unchanged. Country dressed meat and poultry quotations opened unchanged except that young pekin ducks which formerly topped at 25 cents a pound were bid at from 23 cents down to 20, according to weight. Supplies in all lines remained excessive and demand was slow.

First carload of Louisiana strawberries to reach the local fresh fruit and vegetable market entered today at \$4.00 a 24 pint crate. Their excellent conditions drew a good buying interest from retailers. New California cantaloupes were offering at \$4.75 to \$6.00 a crate. Other lines of fruits and vegetables were quotably steady. First pineapple from Cuba are due here early next week.

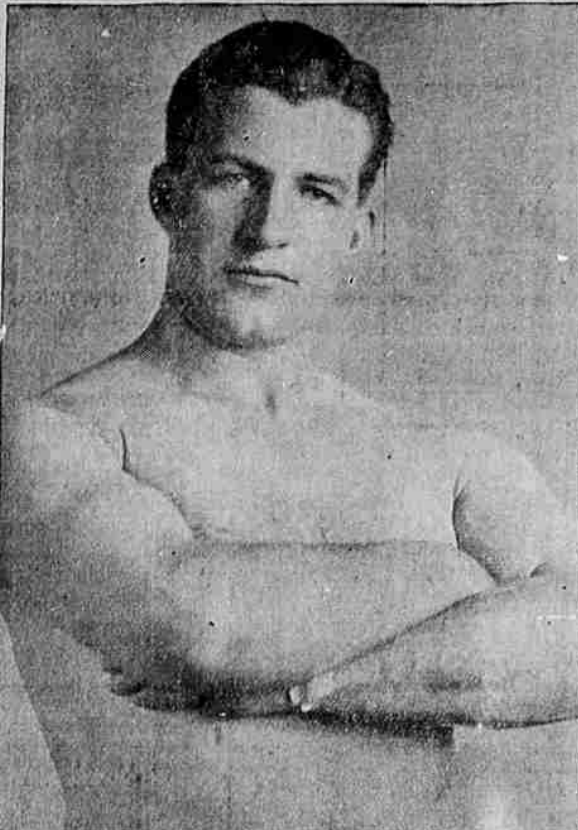

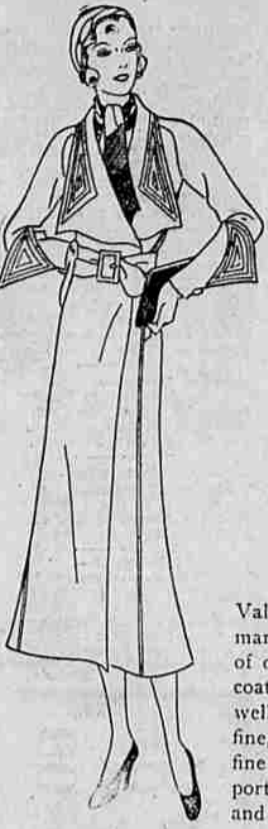
