## WALNUT CROP IN STATE TO HIT NEW PEAK

PORTLAND, May 15 (AP) — Oregon walnut crop at this period promises to not only show the largest tonnage for 1931 but the industry has ever noted, but present prospects are for unusually good quality. This is the text of the latest survey of the nut situation made by the Journal with the co-operation of W. H. Bentley, manager of the North Pacific Nut Growers co-operative.

This unusual showing in the prospective 1931 walnut crop of Oregon was made in face of reports from California that the output there will be not more than 80 per cent of the last five-year average and it is even more than likely that this per cent will not be reached.

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## Mrs. Stanfield, Oregon Pioneer, Dies In Portland

PORTLAND, May 15 (AP) — Mrs. Harriet T. Stanfield, mother of former United States Senator Robert M. Stanfield, died here Wednesday at the age of 77 years.

Mrs. Stanfield was born in Vancouver, Oregon territory, May 5, 1854, but except for her girlhood years had spent her entire lifetime in Oregon. She was married May 6, 1873, to Robert Nelson Stanfield Sr., at the home of her parents in Pendleton. Her early married life was spent at Umatilla Landing, Oregon, where her husband was engaged in business. In 1882 he moved to Pendleton, where he was engaged in the grain commission business until 1888. In that year Mr. and Mrs. Stanfield moved to the Stanfield ranch on Butter creek near Echo, where Mr. Stanfield died in 1888, leaving a widow and six minor children.

Mrs. Stanfield carried on at the ranch for two years and then moved to Pendleton to give the children better educational opportunities. In 1898 her sons took over the ranch. Mrs. Stanfield had lived in Portland since 1908. In addition to the former senator, Mrs. Stanfield is survived by the following children: Hugh L. Echo, Gerald E. Weiser, Idaho; Mrs. Carrie A. Thompson, San Francisco; Daisy C. Palmer, Riverside, Cal.; Mrs. Carl A. Helm, La Grande, Javina Means, Portland, and Katherine M. Stanfield, Echo.

**WOOL MARKET**  
 BOSTON, May 15 (AP) — The Commercial Bulletin of Boston will say tomorrow:

"Business in wool has been generally slow at the eastern seaboard. Some demand is present for fine and half-blood wools at prices which show little change for the week. Medium wools are rather quiet and sometimes easier. Scourings have been slow and barely firm.

"The manufacturers are generally well employed on old contracts which will probably last until about July 1. For the most part, they are well covered against their needs, however.

"In the west, the situation still is unsettled and buyers are in some sections lowering their bids. No snap is noted in the movement of the new clip.

"Foreign markets are a bit easier. London is figured about five per cent under the opening level of prices.

"The rail and water shipments of wool from Boston from January 1, 1931 to May 14, 1931 inclusive were 51,078,000 pounds against 50,708,000 pounds for the same period last year. The receipts from January 1, 1931 to May 14, 1931 inclusive were 50,985,500 pounds against 79,893,900 pounds for the same period last year."

The Bulletin also will publish the following quotations:

Scoured basis: Oregon—Fine and f. m. staple 60-62; fine and f. m. Fr. combed 58-60; fine and f. m. cloth 54-56; valley No. 1 52-54.

Mohair: Oregon — 27-28. Domestic graded—first combing 32; good carding 23-25.

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## WHEAT SOLD TO ORIENT

PORTLAND, May 15 (AP) — Sales of 7000 to 8000 tons of wheat were reported by the farmers' national committee from Portland recently. While the prices was not made public, the trade figures it was around 50c f. o. b.

On the futures market sales for May totaled 10,000 bushels with deliveries of May contract 27,000 bushels for the day. There was no change in the price list of either cash or futures at Portland for the day.

## Curried Potatoes

1. Scoop small sized balls out of raw potatoes.
2. Fill a well greased baking dish with the potatoes and cover with a white sauce made as follows:
- 2 tablespoons butter
- 2 tablespoons flour
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon curry powder
- 2 cups milk

Blend the melted butter and flour together with the seasonings. Gradually add milk and cook in double boiler until thick.

3. Bake at 300 degrees for 2 hours.

## Steamed Beets

1. Peel and slice beets very thin.
2. Place in dish with tight fitting cover.
3. Add 1/2 cup water to beets and cover.
4. Steam in oven at 400 degrees for 2 hours.

## Indian Pudding

- 1-3 cup tapioca
- 1/2 cup corn meal
- 1 quart milk, scalded
- 1 cup molasses
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 2 tablespoons butter
- 1/2 cups cold milk

Method—

1. Scald milk.

2. Stir in tapioca and corn meal.

3. Cook until tapioca becomes transparent.

4. Add molasses and butter and pour into well oiled baking dish.

5. Pour the cold milk over the top.

6. Set in oven without stirring.

7. Bake 1 1/2 to 2 hours at 300 degrees.

## New York Ice Cream in Refrigerator

(Instructions to be given in class)

Tomato-Sauerkraut Cocktail

1. Equal parts of tomato juice and sauerkraut juice. Few drops tabasco sauce.

2. Chill and serve in a small clear glass placed in a green glass filled with ice.

## Surprise Pie

1. Piaky Pastry—
- 1/2 cups flour
- 1/2 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 cup shortening
- Cold water

Method—

1. Sift flour, salt and baking powder together.

2. Cut in the shortening.

3. Save out one-half of this dry mixture.
