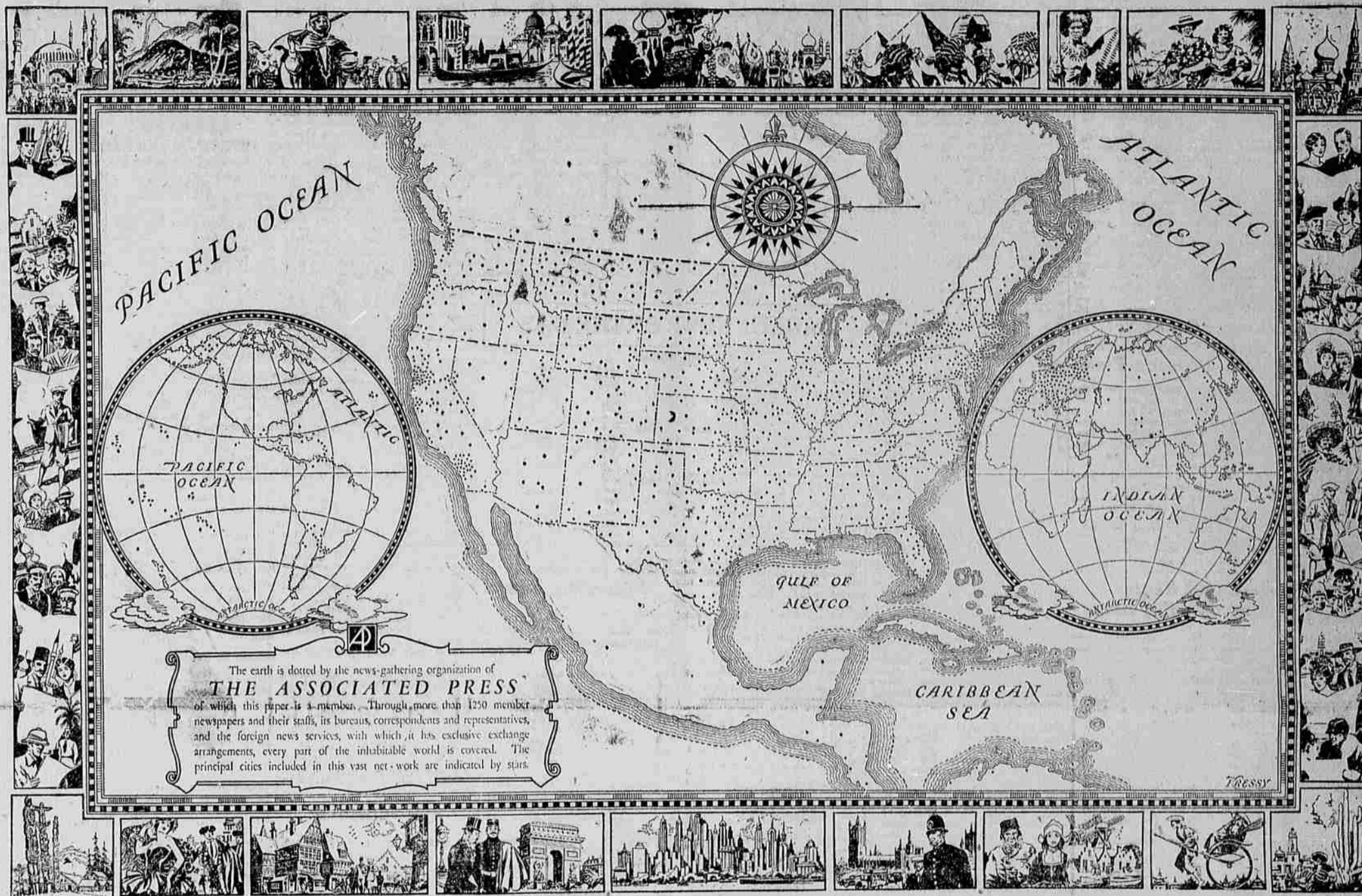


A CORDON OF SENTINELS AROUND THE WORLD!
