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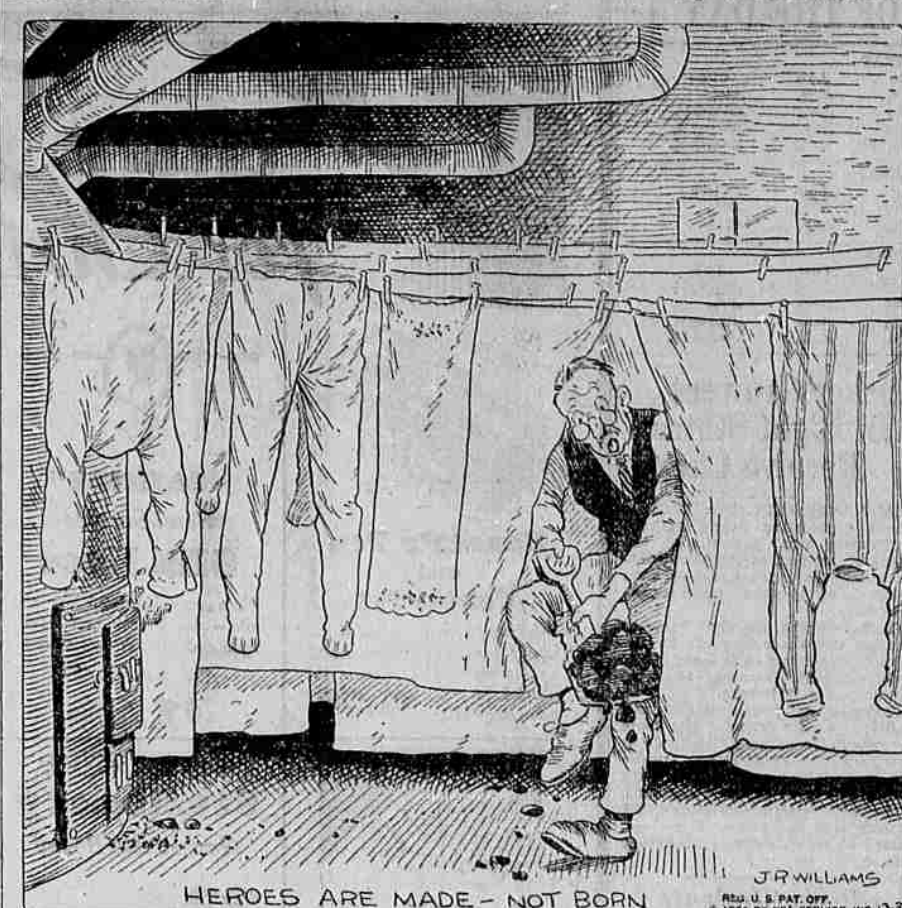

conductive to health and well being. But the capacity of the air to take up water varies with the temperature and with air movement.

In addition, comfort and health are influenced by clothing and activity as well as by humidity.

For our purposes it will not be necessary to go further into the matter of humidity than the effects of dry air upon health.

A relatively dry air is conducive to comfort. An excessively dry and warm air causes an excessive loss of moisture from the body, and consequent irritation of the linings of the respiratory tract.

Infection of the nose, throat and lungs thus is favored.

One may overcome the excessive dryness on the air so common in our homes in winter time by having growing plants about, and by attaching to or placing on radiators containers full of water.

There are also available inexpensive hygrometers by means of which the moisture content of the air may be gauged.

It is worth while paying attention to humidity, for there is a growing conviction that the dry, and frequently dusty air, in our homes favors the development and spread of colds.

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WOMAN, LASSO CAUSE DEATH OF ALABAMAN

FORT PAYNE, Ala., Dec. 3 (A) — A farm woman, who admitted her husband was choked to death after she "lassoed" him with a rope as he tried to flee, and her son were imprisoned here Wednesday on charges of murder.

The prisoners are Mrs. Willie Roberts, 42, and Albert Wood, 28, a son by a former marriage.

She told authorities her husband, William Roberts, 53, attacked Wood with a knife Sunday. She intervened, throwing a noose around Roberts' neck. Then he ran, she added.

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
