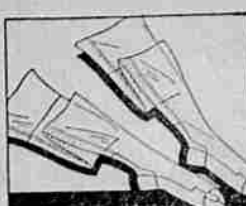

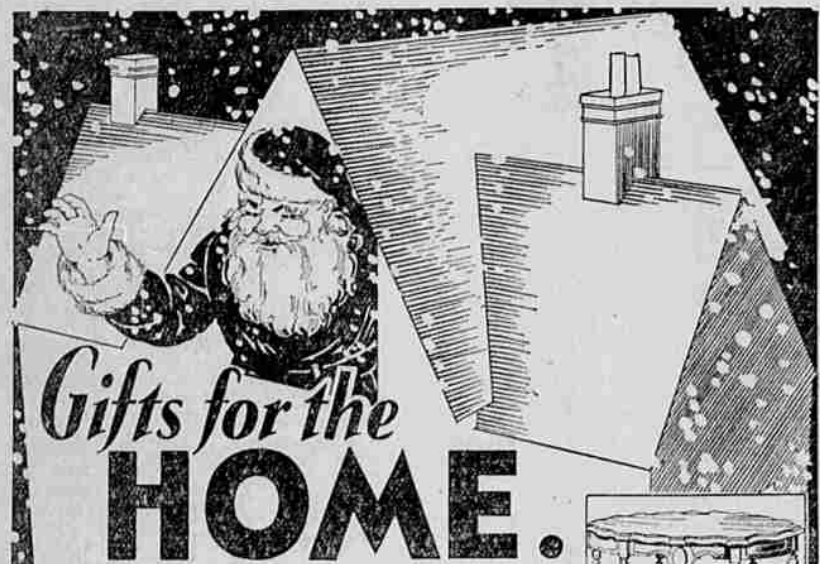

STUDENTS ARE TO PLAY IN PORTLAND

La Grande High Musicians
to Take Part in State
Orchestra, Chorus.

W. W. Nussbaum, director of music at the La Grande High school, will take a group of High school musicians to Portland on Dec. 30 to appear in the chorus and orchestra that will be featured at the meeting of the state music supervisors. The meeting will be held the day following the sessions of the Oregon State Teachers association.

Mr. Nussbaum also has been recognized as an orchestra director of merit and ability and has been invited to direct the orchestra ensemble in three of four numbers. Robert Long and Bernard Posell will play in the orchestra, while those taking part in the choruses are Robert Ward, Ralph Geibel, Aileen Waldruff, Doris Williams, Katharine Wisler, Ella Engel, Arda Berry and Mildred Thompson.

The chorus will sing "Bridal Chorus" from "Rosa Malena," "Pillgrim's Chorus" from "Tannhauser," by Wagner, "A Dream Boat Passes By" by Lemare; "Day Spring of Eternity" by Christiansen; "Montezuma Comes" by Loomis, and "The Leo Shore" by Coleridge-Taylor. The chorus will be accompanied by the orchestra in the Bridal and Pilgrim choruses.

Mr. Nussbaum will direct the orchestra in playing "Maritana Selection," by Wallace; "La Traviata," by Verdi; "March Militaire," by Schubert. The orchestra will also play "Talisman Overture," by Brockton under other direction.

The High school orchestra was presented in the musical program last year, and this year it will be represented in both the chorus and the orchestra.

Couzens Railroad Resolution Adopted

WASHINGTON, Dec. 10 (AP)—The Couzens resolution to authorize a broad investigation of the condition of the railroads by a joint congressional committee was adopted unanimously today by the senate interstate commerce committee.

The resolution, offered by Chairman Couzens of the committee, would set up a joint committee composed of members of the senate committee and of the house interstate commerce committee.

The investigation is intended to find means for the government to alleviate financial difficulties of railroads and distress among their workers.

PORTLAND, Dec. 10 (AP)—Demand was fair in most lines of trade on the east side farmers' market today. There was little change in the general price list.

Potatoes showed a slightly better call. The abundance of junky stock and the scarcity of quality stuff is noticeable. Also the lack of enforcement of the state grading and branding law. No inspector of either the state or the county has been seen for months.

Onions held firm but did not follow the latest advance in the country. Cauliflower sold as low as 35¢ per crate for B's.

Celery market was firm but unchanged values. All root vegetables were in fair call, and at late prices.

Apples sold slowly at 35¢ per box generally.
