chemical apparatus than it would need, resulting in unbalanced equipment.

Jack Peare, former fireman and at present representing Guy Jullius L. Meier's tax conservation organization, also spoke, following the same lines to some extent that Mr. Brady presented. If it is possible, he believes the old truck should be repaired.

J. Y. Walnum was informed, in answer to his questions, that the present pumper is in good condition but that the chemical truck is in need of repairs, with other work required besides tire changes. Commissioner V. R. Melville said that last summer an estimate was made that \$1000 would be needed to put the chemical truck in good condition, but that at present less would be required in all probability. He also said that the commission's idea in considering purchase of a new truck was because of the small amount of water in north side mains and in some other sections of the city, where more than one stream of water from a hydrant was impossible without pumping apparatus.

"Our only thought was to give better fire protection," he said. "We have made no decisions as yet and will give it due consideration and act for the best interests of all." He indicated that it may be a week or two before a decision is reached. He also said that the new offer for changing the tires of the chemical truck was not received until after bids had been called for.

Mr. Melville was elected president of the commission for the coming year and Mr. McAllister was re-appointed city manager. He announced that there would be no changes in the present city official personnel.

A report from the librarian stated that the circulation during 1931 was the largest in history, with 119,753 borrowings, an increase of 11,045. Of the total 19,068 circulation was reported from the branch libraries at Greenwood and Riveria.

The salary list for the month of December, totaling \$5940.87, was ordered paid by warrant.

The manager's report showed \$13,600 paid out during the week on improvement bonds, \$2131.45 general warrants paid, and special interest coupons amounting to \$4391.78, also paid. Cash on hand at the end of the week amounted to \$12,787.21, divided as follows: La Grande National bank \$8840.97, U. S. National bank \$5198.24 and cash \$748.
