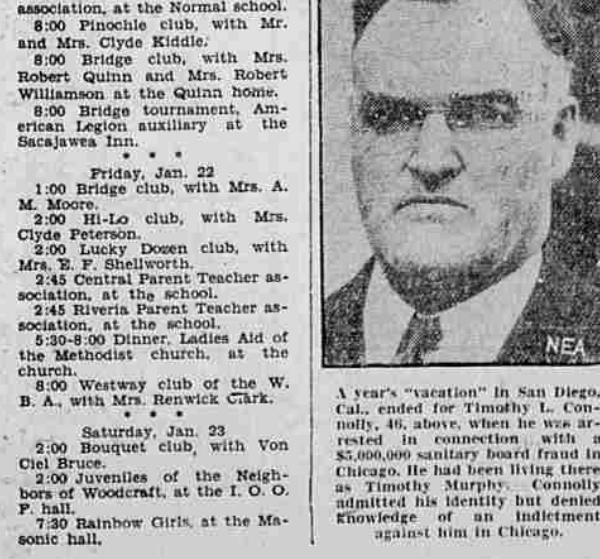
Birthday Dinner Held Last Night
