Shouse Favors Convention With No One Pledged

WASHINGTON, Feb. 10 (AP)—Jouett Shouse, chairman of the Democratic national executive committee, favors a party convention unpledged in advance to any candidate, free to make its choice on the basis of conditions at the time it is held. He disclosed this view in a statement to the Associated Press, made public today. In it he directly denied having combined with former Governor Smith and Chairman Haskin to block the nomination of Franklin D. Roosevelt. Complete impartiality, he insisted, has been maintained both by himself and the national party headquarters.

The Smith statement caused the Louisville Courier-Journal to undertake a poll of Democratic national committeemen and women. Among the states from which one or both of the committee members spoke openly for Roosevelt were Vermont, Georgia, Montana, Nebraska, New Hampshire, Oregon and Washington. Many of the committeemen voiced personal admiration for Smith. Shouse revealed he intends to retire from party management after the convention, which will be held June 27, and that he has no intention of accepting public office thereafter.

He said he had been consulted as to particular candidates by Democrats all over the country, but had invariably advised it would be "easier" from the standpoint of party and country alike not to instruct delegates for anyone except where primary laws of the states made it necessary.

GARNER INTERVIEWED LORDSBURG, N. M., Feb. 10 (AP)—Speaker John N. Garner, of Texas, mentioned as a possible candidate for president, in a personal letter to Willard E. Holt of Lordsburg says he has been too busy to consider the possibility of being a candidate for the nomination.

Holt and Garner have been friends for many years. Holt is secretary of the Lordsburg chamber of commerce.

Abraham Lincoln, who was born 123 years ago on Feb. 12, 1809, has his memories of the people of the United States as one of the leading historical figures of the country, playing an all-important part in holding together the extreme ends of the land during the Civil war. He came through the war, his cause victorious, only to be assassinated before he fully realized the victory.

The Lincoln Centennial observances, which is one of the most beautiful pieces of typical literature of the country, concise and terse yet with a selection of beautiful language, will be presented by Frank Tyler. Sally Sigrist will discuss "Lincoln, the Politician," after which Carl Helm will talk on "Lincoln and the South and Slavery."

A general assembly at the Central school will be an event of Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock, and patriotic songs will be sung by the student body. Patricia Clark will give the "Gettysburg Address" and the children in Mrs. Bessie Gebel's room will sing the "Song of Lincoln."

Small assemblies of one or two rooms will be held at Greenwood school on Friday for singing patriotic songs and hearing stories of Lincoln, while at the Rivera and Willow schools, each room is holding its own program.

Mazurosky Also Indicted by Jury In Bribery Case

PORTLAND, Feb. 10 (AP)—Accused of having offered Mayor George L. Baker \$10,000 in an attempt to influence him to vote favorably on a public market project here, Jack J. Mazurosky, president of the Central Municipal Market company, was indicted by the Multnomah county grand jury late Tuesday.

This was the second such indictment in two days. On Monday Michael E. Rogoway was indicted on the same charge. Bond in each case was fixed at \$3500.

The grand jury continued its deliberations today. Harry L. Gross, attorney for and stockholder in the Central Municipal Market company, yesterday demanded that he be allowed to go before the jury.

The indictments charge that both Mazurosky and Rogoway offered on July 20 last, \$10,000 to Mayor Baker if he would vote in favor of the Fifth street site, as opposed to the First street site. The Fifth street project, it is said, involved considerably in excess of \$1,000,000.

Officers of the Central Municipal Market company, in addition to President Mazurosky, include Kenneth Harlan, vice president; James W. Carey, chairman of the board, and L. C. Simms, secretary-treasurer.

He said Italy rejected the French theory of security to precede disarmament. "Without disarmament," he added, "there can be no security."

He accepted the German demand that other nations disarm in the same proportion as Germany is forced to do under the treaty of Versailles.

He said Italy was in favor of prolonging the Washington and London naval agreements as proposed yesterday by Ambassador Hugh Gibson of the United States.
