MAN HELD FOR U. S.

ASTORIA, Ore., Mar. 2 (AP)—John Chester Clark, wanted in Omaha on a federal indictment charging theft from box cars, was taken from the steamer Admiral Halstead when it docked here last night on its inbound trip from San Francisco. Clark was taken in custody by deputy U. S. Marshal Joe Voegelings, assisted by State Police Sergeant Hickman and Deputy Sheriff Anton Christensen. The officers said Clark admitted his identity but would not talk about the indictment.
