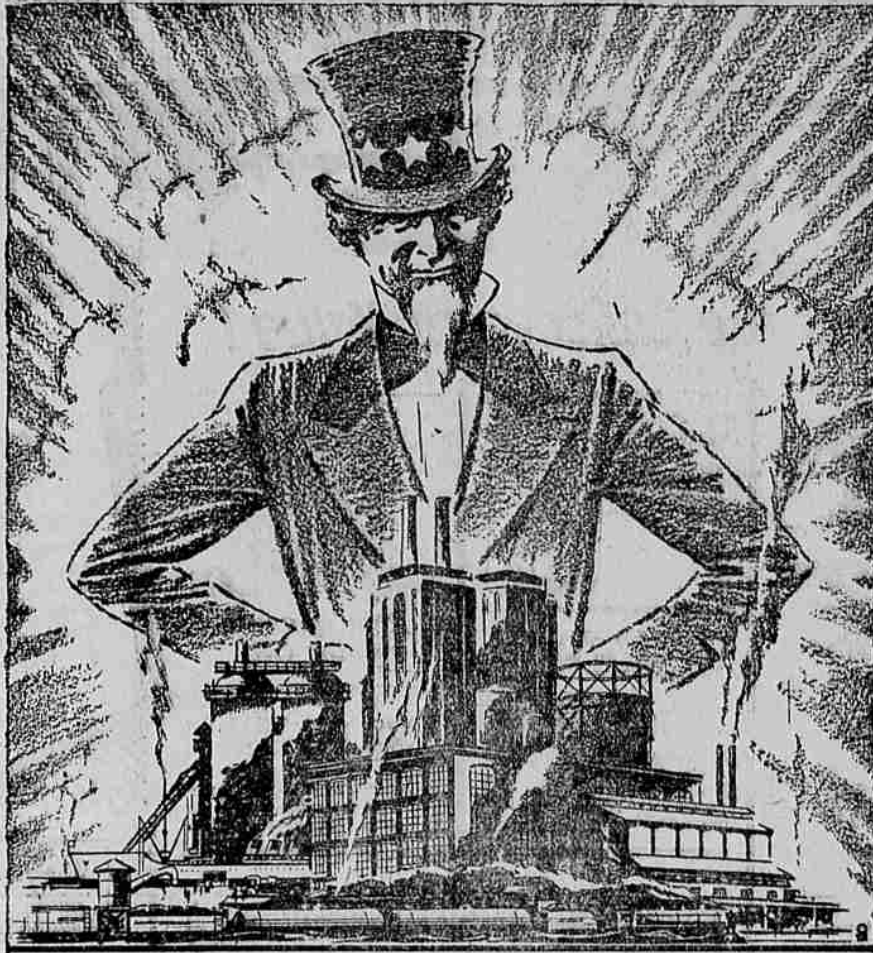


DAWN
