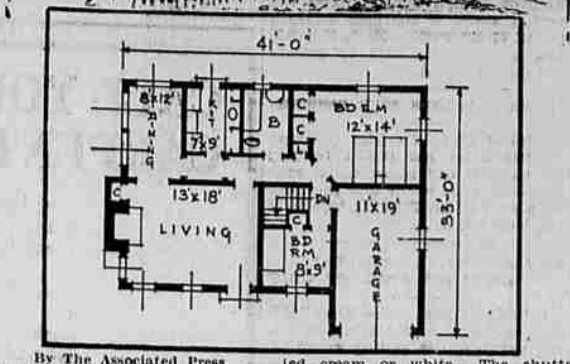

PUZZLE: FIND THE DOOR



By The Associated Press This little bungalow can be built at a very low cost, and any local architect, with reasonable attention, can create a charming effect.

An unusual feature of the house is the almost invisible garage door arrangement. The clapboards run straight through with no trim about the door opening, and the only things that mark it as a door are the small lunge pins and the lock, which, if painted white, also would be practically invisible.

The exterior can be of stucco in some hue off the white, or it can be white if desired. Walls can be of flush siding and could be clapboards painted cream or white.

The shutters should be dark blue green and the roof shingle or slate at the owner's option. The plan is compact and very convenient. There is one large bedroom and a smaller one. Living room and dining porch are almost one room.

This house would be best on a lot 60x125 feet, but could fit on a lot 50x100 feet or longer. With the markets on materials running below their normal level, the cost approximately would run between \$5000 and \$7000, a large portion of which may be obtained on mortgage.

TRY SOMETHING NEW THIS YEAR Variety is the spice of life in vegetables as well as anything else. It pays to vary the crop each year, trying new varieties.

Sweeter peas and corn, tender and snapper radishes, beans devoid of any vestige of strings, tomatoes of beautifully regular shape for slicing, all these are merely matters of studying the seed catalogues and ordering the right varieties of seeds.

Study lists of new vegetables and try a few of them. They are usually selected types of well tried varieties or varieties that show decided improvement in some respect or other from the older sorts.
