Chicago and New York Picked to Give St. Louis Battle For Pennant.

The St. Louis Cardinals are world champions of baseball but the burden of proof is placed squarely on them and their famous chain store system.

It's a large order for a pair of recruits, especially in a league so strongly balanced that not even the 1931 fall ender, Cincinnati, can any longer be regarded as a "set up."

Very likely it will be a three-cornered fight, unless Max Carey can find the right combination with Brooklyn and inject the colorful, modern cast of the pennant play.

The elogen inspired by the Cardinal manager—"Street fears Cincinnati"—is actually typical of the National League outlook. The Reds, even though they have up two crack infielders in the trade with Brooklyn, fortified themselves with Babe Herman, Ernest Lombardi and Wally Gibbons. They haven't a "soft spot" in the circuit now.

Brooklyn, unless it gets exceptional pitching from Hoyt, Vance and Clark, will have trouble keeping in the first division.

Boston has the pitching and its punch should be better with the addition of Fred Leach but the Braves' pitching staff is a good deal better than that to be desired. The Reds, who could stand plenty of it, look vastly improved in every department.
