Tomato Jelly Salad Mold

- 2 tablespoons granulated gelatin 4 tablespoons cold water 3 cups tomatoes 2 bay leaves 2 whole cloves 1 onion slice 1 teaspoon salt 1/4 teaspoon paprika 1 tablespoon sugar

2 tablespoons lemon juice Mix tomatoes, seasonings and sugar. Cover and cook slowly 15 minutes. Strain and heat to boiling point...

Salad Dressing

- 2 eggs or 4 yolks 3 tablespoons flour 1-3 cup sugar 1 teaspoon salt 1/4 teaspoon paprika 1/4 teaspoon celery salt 1/4 teaspoon dry mustard 1/2 cup vinegar 1/2 cup water 2 tablespoons butter Beat eggs and add dry ingredients. Add vinegar and water. Cook in

double boiler until thick and creamy. Stir frequently. Add butter. Mix well, cool and serve.
