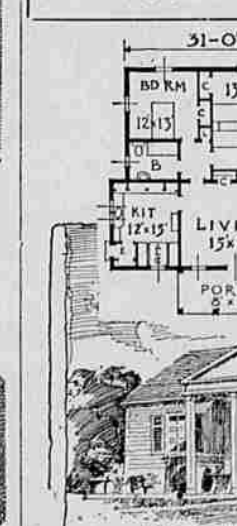

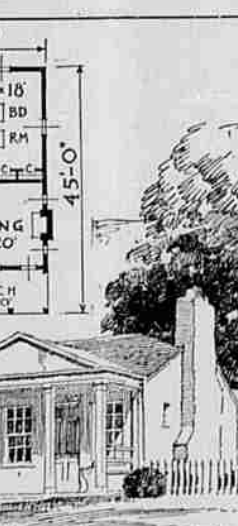

2 cups confectioner's sugar, 4 egg yolks, 4 egg whites, beaten, 1 cup crushed pineapple, 1 teaspoon lemon extract, 24 lady fingers. Cream the butter and add the sugar, egg yolks and beat well. Add egg whites, pineapple and lemon. Line a mold with lady fingers. Add layers of pineapple mixture and remaining lady fingers. Chill 12 hours or longer. Unmold and spread with whipped cream.
