

Officers Balked In Solving of Reynolds Case

WINSTON SALEM, N. C., July 14 (AP)—The mystery of Smith Reynolds' death by a gunshot wound a week ago, deepened rather than cleared by a coroner's inquest, today challenged Forsyth county authorities to solve the most sensational problem they have ever faced.

Officers were reticent in discussing the case, but they said only two explanations were possible: the night watchman overlooked the gun although its location was not hidden, or the weapon was placed there later by some person yet unidentified.

SIX MILLIONS OF U. S. MONEY FOR HIGHWAYS

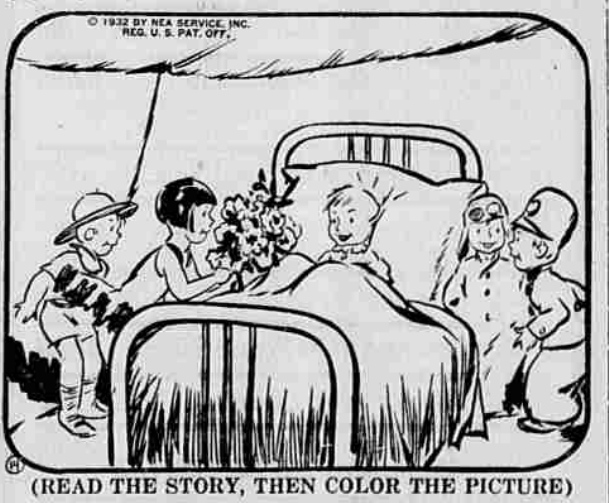
PORTLAND, July 14 (AP)—More than six million dollars of federal money will be available for Oregon's highway system in the fiscal year just started. A Washington, D. C., dispatch to the Journal here said this total comprises \$675,000 of regular unobligated federal aid funds; \$1,468,000 of local road money in the agricultural bill; and \$3,070,000 carried by the relief bill just passed by the senate.

JAPANESE GOVERNMENT RECOGNIZE MANCHURIA TOKYO, July 14 (AP)—The Japanese government, following a series of conferences during the past week, indicated unmistakably to the League of Nations Manchurian investigating commission that it was determined to recognize the independence of Manchuria as soon as it felt the developments of the new regime warranted it. After that, it indicated to the commission, Japan will decline to negotiate further with China or the League of Nations regarding the status of Manchuria. The league commissioners held a final conference today with Foreign Minister Uchida. Secrecy was maintained about the details of the conference but it was stated officially the foreign minister outlined Japan's intentions to all five commissioners.
