TREATING TOXIC GOITER There are several varieties of treatment which, either singly or in combination, are applicable to the sufferer from toxic goiter.

The patient may be treated medically, surgically or by means of X-ray and radium. In many instances the physician is obliged to use a combination of these procedures.

The effects on the body of the intoxication due to toxic goiter are cumulative and the patient who has suffered the disease for a long time makes a poor operative risk, and is not as likely to have good results from his operation as the person spared the prolonged effects of the disease.

heart, the nervous system, the digestion and excretory organs, as well as the function of the higher levels of the brain.

In certain conditions X-ray and radium may be employed in the treatment of toxic goiter. Which of these treatments to employ is a matter to be determined by careful study of each individual case.

The patient who suffers from toxic goiter should not attempt to dictate to his physician the method of treatment, merely because the one he prefers has been known to be effective on someone of his acquaintance who had a "similar case."
