

Nation's Contract Bridge Players In Annual Tourney

NEW YORK, Oct. 18 (AP)—Contract bridge players throughout the United States plan to sit down tomorrow night and match wits for trophies in the American bridge Olympic.

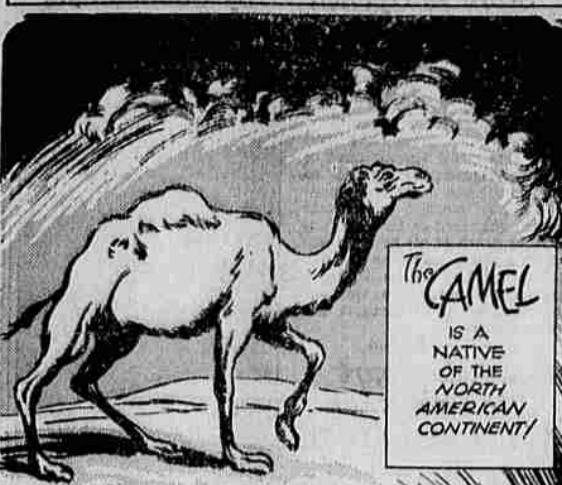

Victor Bokley, running for re-election to the state house of representatives, pledged himself to investigate thoroughly every appropriation bill presented in the house, and to study the matter of reducing state license fees—a question which is difficult because of the large highway indebtedness and the danger of raising the price of gasoline which is already higher than in adjoining states.

J. W. Slater, Democratic candidate for district attorney, pledged himself to uphold all laws on the statute books and to correct certain conditions he said were now existing in the office.

General Pattern of Presidential Campaign Takes Definite Outline

Some surprises may still be in store, but hardly anyone expects any real change from now on either in the basic strategy of the opposing forces or the general style of their respective operations.

The one big fact is that both parties are basing their final bid for power on a conviction that the depression, in all its past and future aspects, will be the paramount factor in the decision of Nov. 8.
