



Out of the Tuna Can

SPINACH RING WITH CREAMED TUNA

4 cups cooked spinach
1 tablespoon butter
Salt and pepper
1/2 cup soft bread crumbs
1 teaspoon minced onion
2 eggs
1 cup medium white sauce

Chop spinach fine. Combine with onion after browning the latter in butter. Season add beaten egg yolks. Next add white sauce and bread crumbs, then fold in stiffly beaten egg white. Turn into a well greased ring mold, place in a pan of hot water and bake in a moderately hot oven (375 degrees) for 35 minutes.

Unmold and fill center with Creamed Tuna

2 tablespoons butter
2 tablespoons flour
1/2 teaspoon salt
4 tablespoons cream
2 cups White Star Tuna
A few mushroom slices (optional)
1 1/2 cups milk
1 egg yolk beaten

Melt butter. Add salt and flour. Stir together well, then add milk slowly. When well blended add egg yolk, cream, mushrooms and tuna fish. Allow to heat thoroughly in top of double boiler. When poured into the spinach ring add a dash of paprika to the top.
