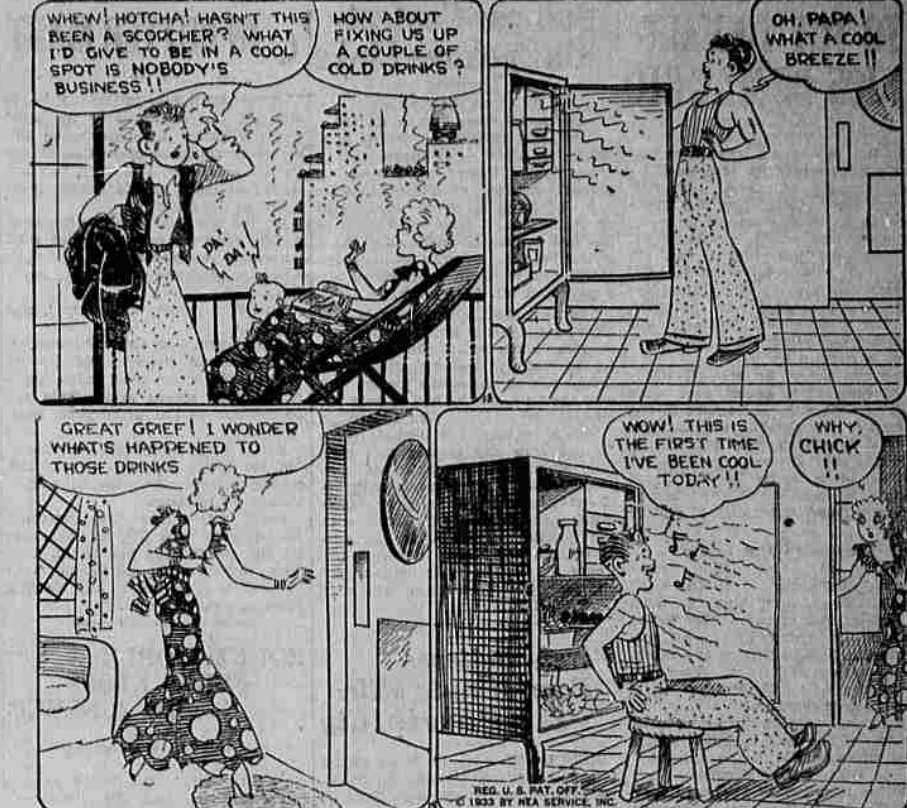

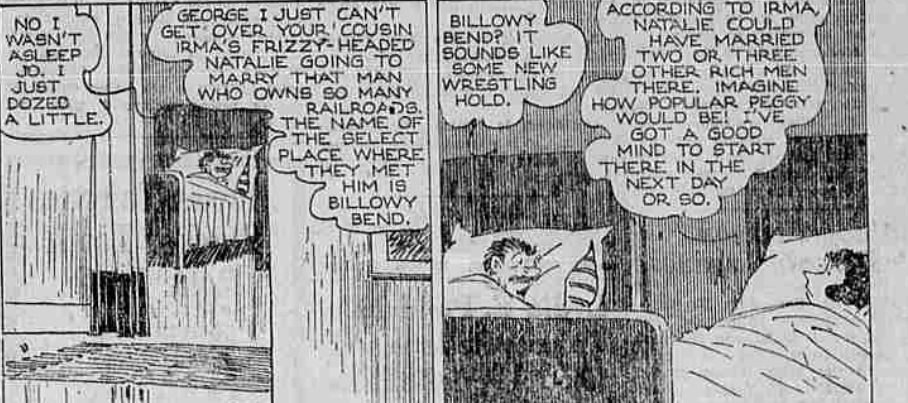

"WAIT! I will catch it," Copy said. "Just watch! I'll get it by the head." Two other Tynmites helped him and the fish soon was held tight.

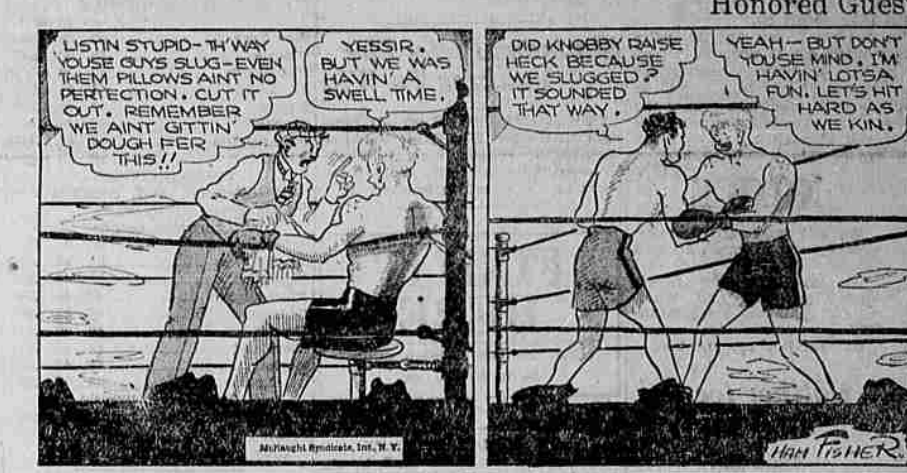
It tried real hard to get away, but Copy said, "You're here to stay. You're going to get some punishment and it will serve you right!"

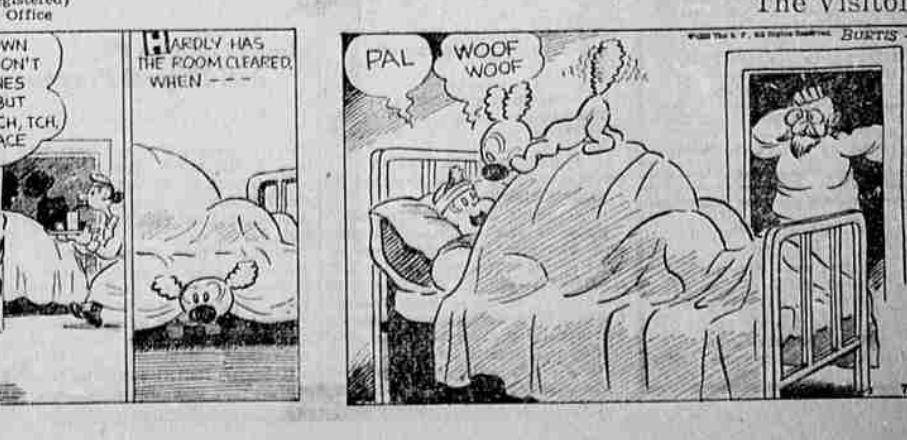
