Corn-Field Philosophy



THERE are lots of places you'd like to be this summer—what with reduced steamship rates, and cruises tagged with almost week-end prices. You'd like to be in sunny Provence, say. And looking over the dinner menu, in leisurely holiday mood you'd consider a trout, a bottle of white wine, chicken a la boreche, a loaf of French bread, pommes au beur, an omelette aux confitures, a neatfatch cheese and finally cafe noir.

Corn is Ripe
But let's be philosophic. Perhaps if you were there, something in the smell of summer sunshine would remind you that it's corn season in the U. S. A. Golden ears are ripe on the tall stalks, tassels are waving in the wind—and ten-

der corn on-the-ear is something to be glad about. Serve it often while it is in season. And keep on your shelf those good grades of whole grain canned corn which retain the corn-on-the-cob flavor because the corn has been picked ripe and the flavor is sealed in. Did you ever serve corn fritters with fried chicken and introduce them with a delicious lemon sherbet? Here is the way the corn fritters are best made:

Corn Fritters: Beat one egg well and add to the contents of one 8-ounce can of corn or one large cup of corn cut from the cob. Mix together one-half cup flour, one teaspoon baking powder and one-fourth teaspoon salt. Add to the corn. Drop by spoonfuls into hot deep fat—375 degrees—and fry until brown.

Dixie Workers Are Delighted With The New Pay Under Code

MACON, Ga., July 28 (AP)—Thousands of cotton mill workers in the deep south opened their pay envelopes today—the first many of them received under the new textile code of the industrial recovery act—and said they thought the recovery act was a dandy idea.

"Do I like the textile code?" said a young mill worker, repeating the question.

"Well, I'll ask you: who wouldn't like 15-20 hours a week less work, and more pay. You see, I used to get 15 cents an hour, worked 60 hours a week, and got \$9 a week. Now I work only 40 hours a week—only five days—and get \$12 a week. Why, the difference will more than pay my rent in the village."

Heat Wave Is Second Warmest on Record

The 27th refuted these hopes, however, with a 102 above, and then on the 28th, the mercury topped 104! Next day normal weather returned.

All that July, 1938 heat wave did was: first equal the old record, then set a new record for heat, and then set an all-time record for consecutive 100-above days of six!

July, 1921, did a fairly good job. On the 19th it was 100 above and on the 20th, 107—tying the new record. But the heat had a relapse then, and it did not reach 100 again until

July 25.
Last year the highest was 98 above. This year attempted to equal the 1928 period, but fell short by two days and one degree. It will rank, however, as one of the hottest summers in local history. Already there has been five days of 100 or higher recorded, the first in June, and more may be in store before the summer is over.

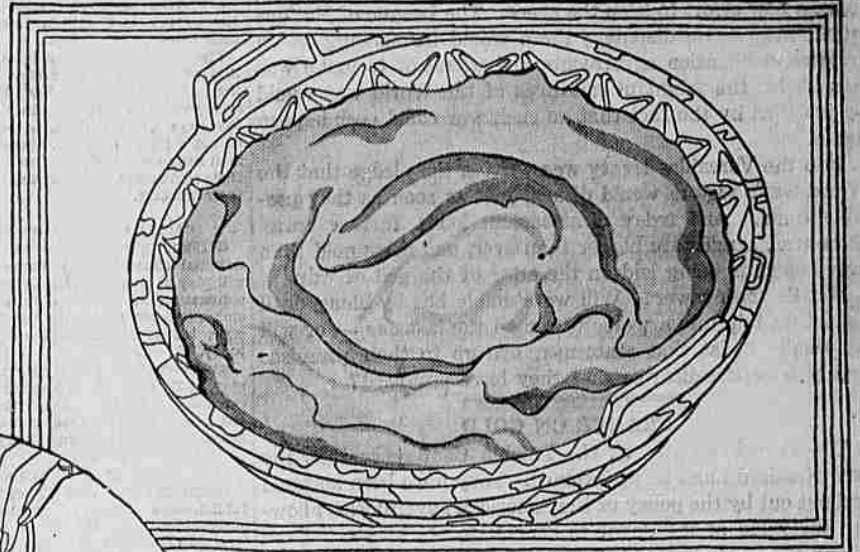
And, just to complete the story, it was 16 below zero here on Feb. 9 this year, making at least a range of 122 degrees for La Grande in 1938.
