PASS THE ONIONS, PLEASE; WHY NOT FRY THEM FIRST? To French fry onions, select a mild one, Bermuda suggested, and cut crossways into one-eighth-inch slices. Soak 10 minutes in cold milk to cover, then drain, dip each slice in light batter and fry until light brown. Drain well and serve with chops or steaks.

HERE'S A HASH HINT Chop your apples and add them to beef hash. You'll find the flavor improved. Chopped real with diced potatoes also is good in hash.

PRESERVING LINOLEUM LUSTER Don't use a stiff brush when washing linoleum. This makes it dull — and no one wants dull linoleum. Use soap and water and wash lightly — almost tenderly — if the luster is to be preserved.

CREAMY BOILED FROSTINGS Boiled frostings become grainy, due to the sugar in them crystallizing. There are several remedies for this. When the sugar and water syrup is boiling do not move the pan nor stir the syrup, as either procedure may cause crystallization. The addition of one teaspoon of vinegar to each cup of sugar will help to prevent the frosting from becoming grainy.

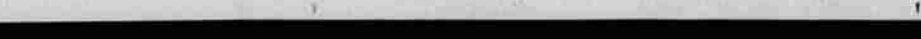

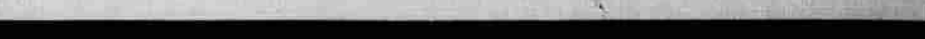
