ing clerical employes but excluding executives, supervisors and their immediate staffs, with minimum wage ranges from 40 to 47 cents an hour as follows:

Middle Atlantic division, New England division, east north central and Pacific coast 47 cents.

In accord with the proposal of the petroleum industry to bring employes of retail outlets under the blanket code the agreement provides a 40 hour week with minimum wages for filling and service station or garage employes engaged in selling gasoline to the public consumer as follows:

Cities between 2,500 and 250,000, \$14.

Cities of less than 2,500 an increase of 20 per cent in wages provided the increase does not involve wages exceeding \$12 a week.

PORTLAND CLINGS TO FIRST PLACE IN COAST LEAGUE

 The San Francisco wallop that tumbled Sacramento from the top rung of the Coast League ladder has not yet toppled Portland off the first place perch.

The Beavers ran into plenty of opposition at Seals stadium last night but came through in the eighth inning with a two-run rally to win 9-2. Jimmy Zinn blanked the Portlanders for six innings and then weakened in the seventh to allow three hits and one run. The Beavers counted and went home on Johnny Moore's triple. George Blackerby's long fly scored Moore. Lou Kouppel held the Seals to seven blows.

Los Angeles moved up into second place as Ray Thomas bested Herman Pilleto in a tight pitching duel, 3-2. Sacramento pounded Sheehan and Bychanan for 10 hits to take the series opener from Hollywood, 7-1, and climb into third place. The defeat dropped the Stars from second to fourth place.

In the day's third pitching battle Bill Ludolph out-tossed Ted Pilleto of the Missions to give Oakland the first game of the series, 3-1.
