

### NUDIST EXPLAINS WHY COLONY PLAN HAS BEEN ADOPTED

Recently Mignon Beck wrote an article which appeared in the Observer in which she described a day spent in the Shasta county, California colony. The following article, also from her pen, gives the nudist's view of the new movement.—The Editor.

ROUND MOUNTAIN, Shasta County, Aug. 17.—In eyes of the American public, nudism, until recently, was something practiced by the Germans or crazy radicals, but of late there has been such a flood of publicity that Mr. Average Citizen is sitting up and taking notice.

"What, ho," he says, "it seems that some crazy galoots are copying the Europeans—bad 'cess to them."  
"Aping the Europeans? Not at all," says the nudist. "Growth of nudism in the United States is merely keeping pace with the evolution of society as a whole. The fear of nakedness is being discarded along with other worn-out traditions of the past."

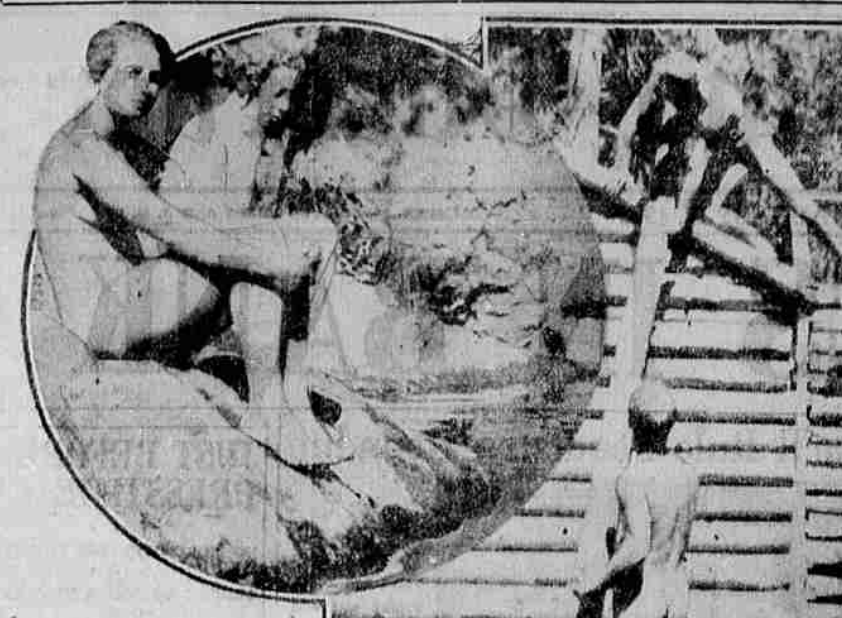
"Bathing suits are becoming more abbreviated each season. Shorts only for men is the accepted thing. Going nude is commonplace in the privacy of the home, and while this is not nudism in the accepted sense, it at least is a step in that direction."

Conditions differ  
Many ask why there have to be nudist colonies. "If I want to go naked," they say, "I take a trip to the country and disrobe without the attendance of secretary of treasury."

The modern factory worker or clerk does not live in a penthouse. Neither has he the time nor the money to look for inaccessible places in the country where he may remove his clothes without danger of being exposed.

Stuart Chase, economist, an advocate of nudism, says: "I shrink from the Teutonic organizations of the modern nudists. I like to sunbathe when the moon shines in, and I like the adventure of finding the proper spot away from other people, but I

realize my good fortune in having more time and space than the average working man. If he and his family are to sunbathe at all, they must have organized facilities."

There you have the reason for organized colonies and gymnasiums. The average person must have a private place not too far from the city if he is to enjoy nudism while vacationing. And if he is to go nude while in the city he must do so without benefit of instruction in gymnastics, swimming and the like unless he joins a group.

The greatest danger to this growing movement is not public opinion or reformers and kibitzers, but from pseudo-nudist outfits whose purpose is to attract the prurient-minded. They already have kept away from the real nudist movement many people in search of the healthful benefits of sunshine.

So long as they bother no one you might say the law clothes people with the right to go naked. In California the law says:

"Every person who wilfully or lewdly either (1) exposes his person... in any public place where there are present other persons to be offended or annoyed thereby, or (2) procures, compels or assists any person to so expose himself or to take any part in any model artist exhibition or to make any indecent exposure of his person to public view or to the view of any number of persons such as is offensive to decency or is adopted to excite lewd or vicious thoughts or acts is guilty of a misdemeanor."

Looking over this statute, it does not seem that a nudist colony in California or states with similar laws would be molested unless it carried its nudism into a public place—which is extremely unlikely.

### PORTLAND CLUB IS AGAIN BEATEN BY STARS 13-4

Roy Joiner, of Oakland, southpawed his way to a double victory yesterday, trimming San Francisco 9-5, and dropping Joe Dimaggio, the Seals' kid sensation, to the dirt with a left hook.

The usually mild-tempered Joe, holder of the Coast league consecutive game hitting mark, questioned an umpire's decision calling him out when he slid home in the first inning. Pitcher Joiner took the argument to heart, Joe replied with a swing at the Oakland tosser and the latter countered with the knockdown punch.

The Missions drew farther away from the cellar by making it two straight over Seattle, 14-7.

### ABBOTT LOOKING FOR A NEW JOB

LOS ANGELES, Aug. 17.—Spencer Abbott, who piloted the Ducks to their 1932 pennant, is on the block.

The black-browed manager of the Portland aggregation in the Pacific Coast league put himself there last night because, he said, he could see no future in tilting the Oregon city's baseball fortunes any further upstream.

"I feel," he said, "I've done the best I could with the team and would like to try myself out somewhere else. I feel perfectly justified in placing my candidacy before other owners who may contemplate making changes in managerial places for 1934."

No, he said at first, there had been no disagreements with Tom Turner, Portland president, but he altered that statement a moment later to concede that there had been a few arguments.

"But they have not been the direct cause of my announcement," he hastened to add.

Elgin Saturday. Other communities which have completed their schedule of elections include Imbler, Aug. 21; Summerville, Aug. 22 and North Powder, Aug. 23, all at 8 p. m. Communities holding meetings this week are expected to complete the schedule for elections so that the entire country will have a permanent organization by about Aug. 28.

Application blanks, copies of the final contract and forms for mapping the farm, its yield and the disposal of the crop, have been received by the county agents and are being put into the hands of the farmers themselves as fast as the schedule of meetings can be carried out. Since only those who have signed applications are eligible to vote, farmers are advised to prepare a memorandum of cropping history on their farms and to secure a report of grain delivered at the warehouse during the past four years.
