MRS. ROOSEVELT CHOOSES DRESS OF BLUE VOILE

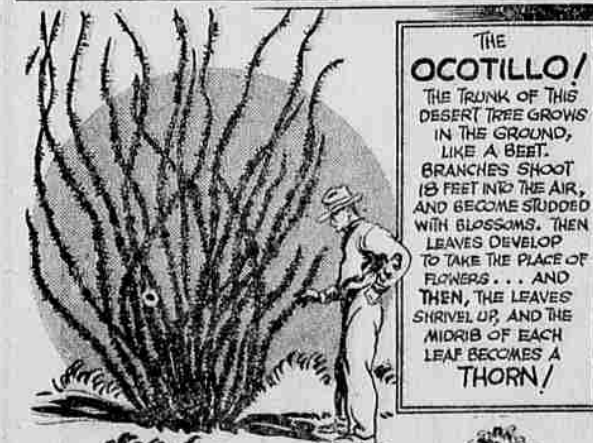
