Sales of Dodge Cars Continue To Show Increase

Dodge dealers' sales of passenger cars and trucks - which for the period January 1 to September 2 were 218.4 per cent of sales recorded in the corresponding period of 1932, increased their lead ratio, with the holiday week ending September 9 added, to 224.8 per cent, according to reports received by L. C. Smith, local Dodge dealer.

Retail deliveries by Dodge dealers of Dodge and Plymouth passenger cars to date this year are 227.8 per cent of sales made during the like 36 weeks of 1932. Sales of Dodge trucks during the period rose from 6,827 in 1932 to 13,199 so far in 1933. The summary of Dodge dealers' business in new passenger cars and trucks gives a total of 123,014 retail deliveries for 1933, as compared to 55,193 in 1932, says the report.

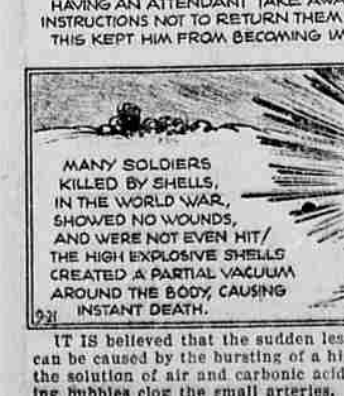
