has been signed and power items in the new budget do not include the proposed reduction. It was explained that if the municipal power plant in connection with the Beaver Creek pipeline project, is built, no power item will be necessary. If the project is not built, the city officials inferred that the E. O. L. & P. Co. offer would be accepted. Power items in the budget, total \$14,300, including \$1500 in the street department, \$2500 in the water department, and \$10,000 for street lighting.

Going through the items one by one, reductions, increases are herewith shown:

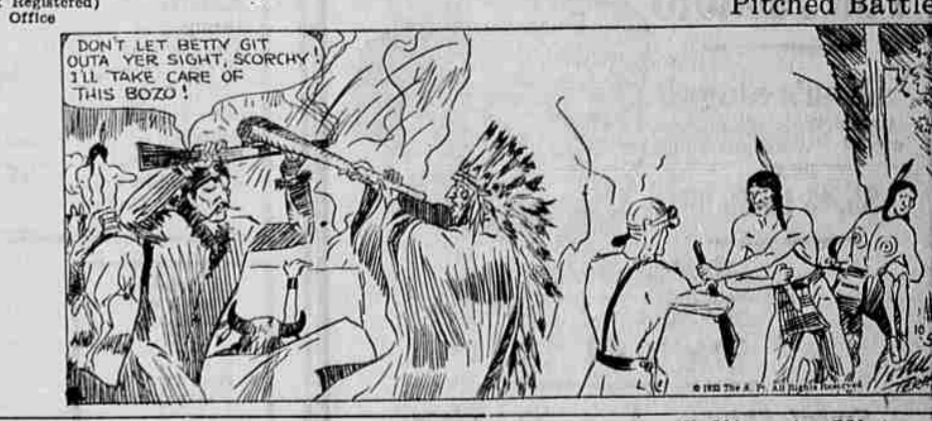
