A black and yellow food costume. HALLOWEEN SALAD

1 pkg. orange flavored gelatin.  
1 cup water  
1/2 cup orange juice  
1/2 cup pineapple juice  
Pinch of salt  
2 cups dried prunes  
1 cup pineapple wedges  
1 cup carrot cut in strips  
Orange sections  
Whipped cream

Dissolves orange gelatin in water, add salt and fruit juice. Pour in enough of this mixture to just cover the bottom of a ring mold which has been dipped in cold water. When gelatin is firm, arrange prunes, cut into strips, over it. Pour over the rest of the gelatin mixture with the pineapple and carrot added to it. When firm, remove from ring and fill center with sweetened whipped cream and sugared orange sections.
