## State Policemen Arrest 453 Last Month in Oregon

SALEM, Ore., (P)—State police arrests totaling 453 in traffic violations, 280 in general law enforcement and 129 in the game law division were reported by Superintendent Charles P. Pray for the month of September.

In traffic violations, an increase was noted in the number of intoxicated automobile drivers for a total of 36 for the month. Sixty-eight were arrested without driver's licenses, 57 for reckless driving and 42 in connection with the motor transportation act. Total fines assessed for traffic violations were \$5562, and fees of \$10218 were collected.

In the general law enforcement, activities included arrest resulting in a life sentence of one murderer, 44 on petty larceny charges resulting in 10 years' imprisonment and \$291 fines and 20 burglar arrests resulting in nine years' imprisonment of the cases completed the largest number of arrests in 1933 in fines. Total fines for this division was \$1742, and 23 years'
