THE ELK THAT DIDN'T REACH TOWN

Nearly a week after the first open elk season since 1907 came to a close, and still the discussion rages.

And comes the game commission with a statement that it estimates only 300 elk killed in Union, Umatilla, Wallowa and Baker counties.

Seasoned hunters tell us that there were many who went into the woods merely for the sport of shooting the wapiti;

It is safe to say that probably 40 per cent of the elk killed remained on the field of battle — which, from the cannonading that resounded in some sections of Eastern Oregon

The open elk season in Eastern Oregon this fall can be written off the book with a few words — a small percentage of meat preserved unspoiled, a larger proportion brought into town in a somewhat smelly condition, another large proportion left to rot in the woods, an unusually large kill of deer

because of arrival of so many additional hunters from other sections, and lastly, creation of a feeling of animosity toward state game heads among nimrods of this section that it will take years to heal.

Repeal of the eighteenth amendment, arriving with a speed few people in America thought possible, does not simply mark the end of a great experiment.

Let beer, in other words, be sold by almost anybody who cares to get a license. Let wine be served freely with meals in hotels, restaurants, and cafes.
