Cards and Bears Agree to Battle "Fair And Square" For Famous Axe

BERKELEY, Cal. (AP) — Added zest will be given victory in this year's annual "Big Game" between University of California and Stanford by the decision of the Stanford student body to put up as a trophy the axe over which the two institutions have warred for 34 years.

This rustic implement was first used by Stanford in 1889 to illustrate its famous axe yell, being employed to decapitate an effigy of a California sympathizer. It was taken by force from the hands of Stanford rooters in April of that year and for 21 years was kept secretly hidden in Berkeley, except when brought out at the annual football rally to ink their rivals down the peninsula.

In 1900, under the guise of being motion picture operators for a news reel, 31 Stanford students succeeded in recapturing it and rushing it to Palo Alto in the supposed motion picture truck.

There it has since reposed in a bank vault until as a gesture of good will it was mounted on a mahogany base and by agreement with California designated as a trophy to be held each year by the school winning the annual football game.

Many bloody noses, bruises and torn clothes resulted from the numerous clashes that broke out between the two universities in efforts to gain possession of the axe in past years. Armored cars, tear gas bombs and numerous weapons of attack were used.

Nelson Pleads For Education Harmony In State Schools

PORTLAND, Nov. 3 (AP) — A plea for harmonious co-operation, and condemnation of what he described as "defeatist tactics," characterized two addresses made Thursday by Roscoe C. Nelson of Portland, president of the state board of higher education, who visited the campuses of University of Oregon, and Oregon State college.

In an address before faculty members and students at Eugene, Mr. Nelson criticized such persons as have, he said, been subtly sabotaging the efforts of Chancellor W. J. Keer. "Dr. Kerr is sincere," the chairman declared. "He is not out to harm the university, as some would have us believe."

(Continued from Page One) self," Dr. Millikan said. Measurement of electron volt energies of these particles up to 3,000,000 volts has been made accurately, he revealed.

"These rays are drilling holes straight through your bodies, from head to heel, and you like it," he said. "They come from the celestial dome, independent of the positions of the great celestial masses, such as the sun, the stars and the Milky Way."

"They are darts of light, corpuscular, composed of bullet-like things, that is they cling together for long distances."
