Miss Florence Day, director of dramatics at the Eastern Oregon Normal school, traced the development of drama through the past century yesterday afternoon at the La Grande Neighborhood club meeting at the La Grande hotel.

Stock companies in which the greatest players of America came together, the theatre trust which brought about the star system of production; road shows gave way to the little theatre, and the little theatre which died down more or less with the advent of talkies, were the main vehicles of the drama which Miss Day sketched.

The birth of American drama was attended with great difficulty, she said. The Puritans thought the theatre was an institution for saving souls and it was long before it could be accepted as an institution of art.
