

CITY TO CALL IN INTEREST COUPONS SOON

An order was given to the city recorder-treasurer during last night's commission meeting to notify all improvement bond holders of the city of La Grande, that interest on their bonds during the period from Dec. 1, 1933 to Nov. 30, 1934, would be prorated, according to the money on hand, provided they surrender their coupons. A similar order was given a year ago and payments on coupons due Dec. 1 will begin soon, at the rate of 16 cents on the dollar, provided the coupons are surrendered.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 16 (AP) — For the third successive day, the administration today set a price of \$33.48 an ounce for reconstruction corporation purchases of newly mined domestic gold.
