

STANFORD WILL PLAY ROSE BOWL GAME NEW YEAR'S

SAN FRANCISCO, Nov. 27 (AP)—Toward football battlefields across the continent Stanford turned today for the opponent it will face New Year's day in Pasadena in the Rose Bowl classic that annually comes closest to determining the country's mythical football champion.

Preliminary steps in the negotiations to select a representative team from the eastern half of the nation found the undefeated and untied eleven of Princeton and Army as those unofficially favored in a list that includes Michigan and Duke universities.

While those in charge prepared to weigh the claims of outstanding prospective opponents, Stanford students continued their jubilation over the '7-3 win from California that earned the Cardinals a tie with Oregon for the conference title.

Both Stanford and Oregon completed the conference schedule with four wins, one defeat and no ties. Stanford, however, defeated Southern California, 13-7, whereas Oregon lost to Southern California, 26-0. Oregon State also finished its conference with only one defeat but was tied once. Southern California has one conference game to play, against Washington, Dec. 9, but is expected to win that contest to end up with a record that includes one defeat and one tie.

In the only other conference game Saturday Washington State defeated Washington 17-6. In a non-conference encounter University of California at Los Angeles fell 22 to 14 before St. Mary's.

A Thanksgiving day game will see Washington State and the University of California at Los Angeles Bruins wind up their conference schedules. Other teams, except Washington and Southern California, have completed theirs.

Oregon and St. Mary's will meet in their annual game, Thursday in San Francisco, while Idaho will pair off with Gonzaga at Spokane in another interesting encounter.

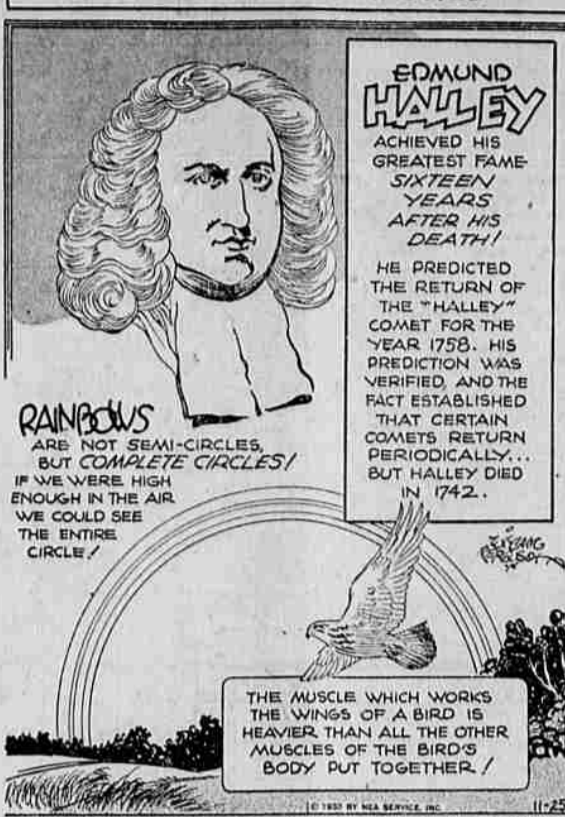

Efforts were being made today to high Jimmy Chandler and Lloyd Hutchinson for a bout on the bill. Dick Russell, who refereed the disputed Leighton-Hutchinson set-to, explained his version of the decision again today as he had done before.

"One of the judges wrote only the initial of who he thought won the Leighton-Hutchinson bout. He claimed it was an H for Hutchinson, but it looked like a letter L to me and inasmuch as I believed the two judges had disagreed I awarded the bout to Leighton by a close margin," Russell commented.

A banquet for the amateurs who took part in the tourney last week is to be held one night this week at the date and place to be announced.

BEWARE OF RICKETS

As the winter season approaches and the days become shorter and colder, and outdoor life more restricted, man becomes increasingly predisposed to the development of rickets.

Rickets is a seasonal disease which begins to increase in the fall and becomes more widespread and more serious in winter.
