Prize Winners In Convict Rodeo Not To 'Blow In' Cash

HUNTSVILLE, Tex. (AP)—Turning thumbs down on such polite projects as stage plays and glee club concerts, Texas convicts put on a real show for the public—a highly successful rodeo.

At a series of riding and roping exhibitions they drew an estimated total of 20,000 spectators, including Senator Tom Connally. About 50 convicts from the penitentiary and various prison farms took part in each performance. Twelve hundred "good behavior" inmates were brought to Huntsville from penal farms to watch the fun.

Forty-three "wild and woolly" steers were obtained for the contests.

Gross gate receipts were \$2637, or five times as much as last year's entertainment brought in. Riders were awarded cash prizes of more than \$500, accompanied by an admission to "spend it elsewhere than in riotous night life."

Judges selected Roy Cox, formerly of Moab, Utah, as the best all-around performer.
