

MOVIE FILMED IN EASTERN OREGON COMING SUNDAY

Farm houses, built during the early history of Eastern Oregon, and fields of ripe wheat extending to the far horizon were the lures that drew the company making "Golden Harvest," which plays Sunday and Christmas day at the Liberty, and the vicinity of Pendleton during the middle of the past summer when most of the scenes of this unusual picture were filmed.

Richard Arlen, Chester Morris, Genevieve Tobin, Roscoe Ates, and other members of the cast spent over a month on the ranches of Ike Christopher and L. L. Rogers near Pendleton making scenes for this picture of the wheat farmers and their attempt to bring the price of wheat back to a profit paying level. The Christopher ranch was homesteaded in 1878 by its present owner and expanded to its present proportions as one of the largest wheat ranches in Oregon. The L. L. Rogers farm was started in 1891 and now comprises over 3000 acres including ranch buildings and wheat land.

The intense summer heat of 110 degrees in the shade made it not only difficult for the actors, many of whom had to wear heavy winter clothing for winter scenes, but also presented a problem to the sound technicians working with the cast near Pendleton. Sound in the extreme heat goes directly up, and so after much experimenting it was found that microphones had to be placed directly over the actors.

When the movie company began its work on the Christopher ranch last summer a call for 100 extras was made, and over 1000 hands, ranchers, cowboys, shepherders, and people from Pendleton's idle class responded to the call. One man from La Grande was employed, but the intense heat proved too severe, and because of his advanced age he succumbed to sun-stroke after working in one of the winter scenes.

Members of the cast, headed by Richard Arlen and staff made up a very liberal purse for the family of the deceased extra player. Many people from La Grande visited the location of this motion picture company last summer in hopes of catching a glimpse of Richard Arlen, Roscoe Ates, Genevieve Tobin, or Chester Morris. C. M. Wright, manager of the Liberty theatre here, spent one day with the company both chatting with the stars and watching the filming of the picture.

morning the mercury was at 49 above, promising even higher temperatures today than on Tuesday, when the high was 52.

The Oregon weather forecast calls for occasional rains tonight and tomorrow, little change in temperature, and a continuance of the southerly gales off the coast. So far this month there have been only seven days with the minimum temperature below freezing, and only one day with the maximum no higher than freezing point—33 above. The minimum so far this December has been 24 above, recorded about a week ago.
