Coach Quinn and his team returned late Saturday from Nampa when they won one and lost two games in an invitational college tournament, which was won by Northwest Nazarene college with three straight victories. Gooding college, which defeated the Mountaineers 26 to 25 in the second round of the tourney, finished in second place. College of Idaho finished third by defeating Albion Normal 49 to 44. Albion broke even with E. O. N., losing in the third round 44 to 39 and winning in the third round 45 to 37.

E. O. N. was linked out of playing in the finals. Gooding college trailed E. O. N. four or five points throughout the second round, and the Mountaineers held a four-point lead about a minute before the game ended.
