Hilding's three points not only gave his team victory, but it put him in high point position with 13, closely followed by Miles, Lewiston forward, and Peterson, who broke even with a dozen each. Miles and Peterson, rivals in four games the two schools have played this year, kept each other pretty effectively covered, and every shot either made was well earned. Conklin scored a free throw for E. O. N. to start the game, but Lewiston soon tied it and ran up a 10 to 1 lead, before the Mountaineers started. Then Halverson's two free throws and a field goal, and field goals by Conklin and Peterson put the count 12 to 10 against E. O. N. at the half.

The second half was one of those nip and tuck affairs, with first one and then the other team holding a two-point lead, and it continued right up to the final two minutes of play.

The two teams were practically even in floor play, but in the fading moments, Lewiston and a little more of that sturt that wins games.
