WHITE RAJAH REFORMS THE SARAWAK MARRIAGE

SINGAPORE (AP)—Sir Charles Vyner Brooke, hereditary white rajah of Sarawak in northwest Borneo, has issued a new law to protect the sanctity of the marriage bond.

Six months in jail and a fine of \$50 is the penalty decreed for erring husbands or wives. A similar punishment is provided if either is physically or mentally cruel to the other or deserts the home.

Sarawak, with its 400,000 natives, has been ruled by the Brook family since 1859 when Sir James Brooke received the post as reward for suppressing a rebellion against the sultan of Borneo.

STALIN'S NAME BESTOWED UPON SIXTH SOVIET CITY

MOSCOW (AP)—One more town has been named for Joseph Stalin, known in this country as secretary-general of the communist party and known to the world as the dictator of the Soviet Union.

In December a huge chemical plant was opened at Bobrsk, not far from Moscow, and soon afterward 25,000 workers at this plant petitioned to change the name of the city to Stalingrad. The government approved the recommendation.

This is the sixth city in the U. S. S. R. to bear Stalin's name. The others are Stalingrad, formerly Tsaritzin, on the lower Volga; Stalino, formerly Uzoovka, in the Donets coal basin; Stalinsk, capital of the republic of Tadjikistan in the Caucasus; Stalinsk, a new steel and coal center in the Kuznetsk region of Siberia; and Stalin in Uzbekistan.
