COMPENSATION FOR INJURED IS CHANGED

New rulings as regards payment of compensation to disabled G. W. A. workers have been received by the local civil works board. For disability incurred while at work compensation of up to two-thirds may be paid, except that a maximum of \$5.75 a week exclusive of the cost of medical care is provided for. This applies to all payments, regardless of date of injury, also includes unpaid claims. No adjustment, however, is required for claims already paid. Compensation is paid for traumatic injuries and not for disease, except when disease is a direct result of wounds received while employed by the G. W. A.

No change has been made in the medical procedure, it is said.
