GREAT BRITAIN'S '34 NAVY PROGRAM LISTS BIG SHIPS

LONDON, Mar. 7. (P) — Construction of four new cruisers and many other craft is provided for under increased navy estimates for 1934 just announced by Great Britain.

The navy estimates for 1934 total 2,990,000 francs (\$14,900,000).

In addition to providing for a ships construction program, the estimates also make provision for increasing the naval personnel.

The construction program included:

Four cruisers — Three of the new minotaur type and one of the arctura type.

One leader and eight destroyers; Three aircraft carriers.

Three submarines — One mine layer submarine and two of the "S" or patrol type.

Under the estimates, the personnel of the fleet will total 92,338 officers and men—an increase of 2,038—and 894 royal marine police, an increase of 19.

Pacific Builder Reports Gain In Coast Building

SAN FRANCISCO, Mar. 8. (P) — The Daily Pacific Builder reports a survey of 95 cities and counties of the Pacific coast shows building permits for February gained 66 per cent over February last year. Total permits amounted to \$5,413,203 against \$3,304,192 a year ago.

The group reported \$5,097 permits, compared with 3870 last year.

"The increase in value of work is due principally to privately financed industrial and commercial building and alterations," the construction newspaper pointed out. Permits included:

Oregon, 7 cities — 332 permits against 265, value \$183,967 vs. \$133,269.

Idaho, 3 cities — 61 vs. 22 and \$28,329 vs. \$9,314.

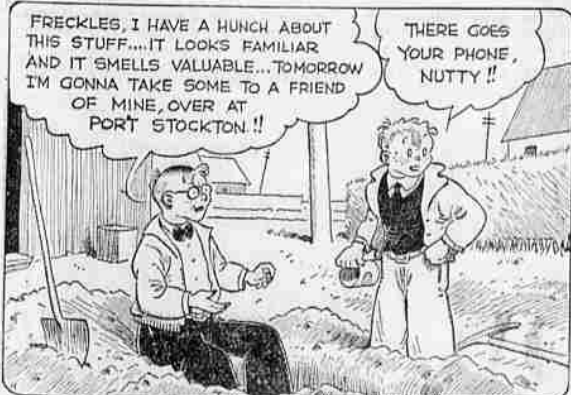

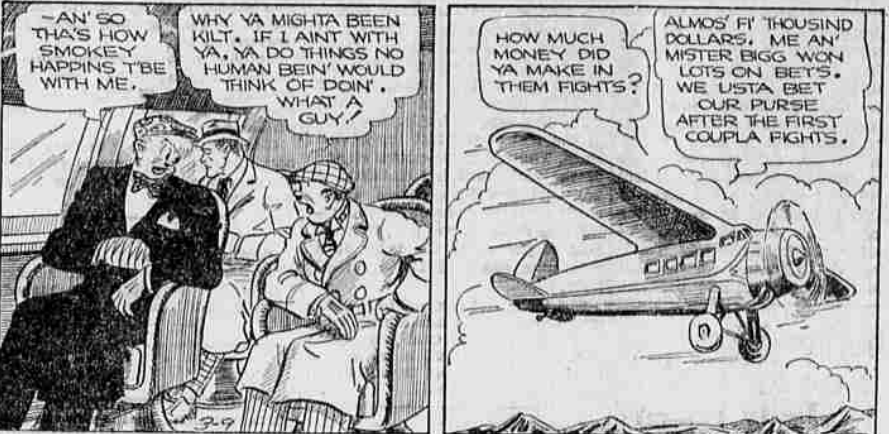

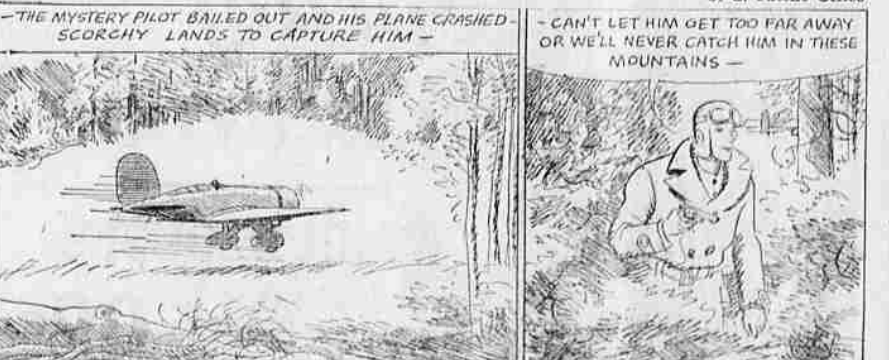
