Income Tax Returns Are Ahead of 1933

PORTLAND, Mar. 14 (AP)—Income tax returns this year are running ahead of the corresponding period a year ago, the collector of internal revenue said today. Returns filed to Tuesday exceeded by about 200 those filed last year.

There have been 11,998 returns this year, compared with 10,012 in 1933. Of the returns, 3,461 were on taxable incomes, and 8,537 were on non-taxable incomes. The filing period closes at midnight Thursday.

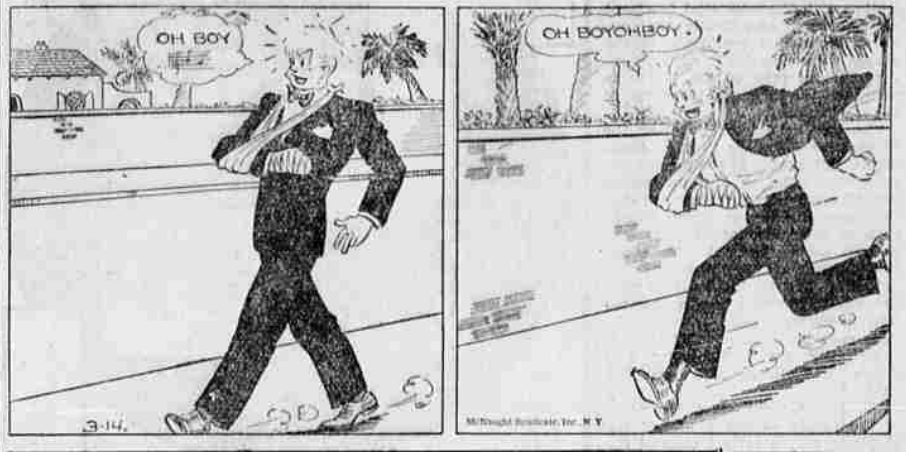

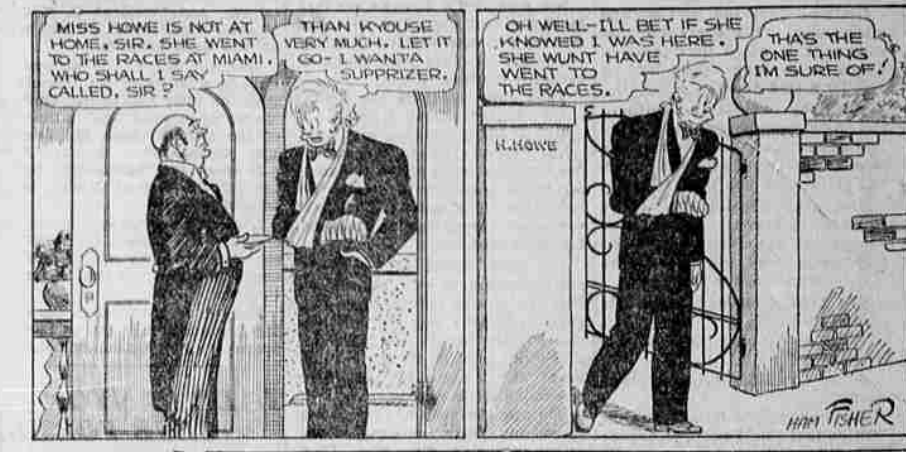
